#### On-Campus Component

The programme includes two immersive on-campus modules designed to deepen cohort connection, facilitate experiential learning, and anchor the transformational journey.

The **exact dates for these residential immersions** will be communicated well in advance to allow participants to plan their travel.

In light of our recent experiences with the COVID-19 pandemic, the scheduling and format of these modules will remain responsive to public health conditions at the time. Should in-person gatherings become impractical, the on-campus components will be seamlessly transitioned to extended virtual formats, with additional live sessions conducted on Sundays and supplementary Saturdays, ensuring continuity of learning and cohort engagement.



### Eligibility

- Educational Qualification
  - For Indian participants: A graduate degree (10+2+3) or a diploma (10+2+3) from a recognized university or institution approved by UGC/AICTE/DEC/AIU/State Government.
  - For international participants: A graduate or equivalent degree from a recognized university or institution in their respective country.
- Professional Experience
  - A minimum of 15 years of full-time work experience, with demonstrated leadership responsibilities
- Personal Readiness
  - A sincere desire to introspect, grow from within, and engage with the personal dimensions of leadership to address both internal and external challenges.

- Current CXOs managing cross-functional portfolios and strategic initiatives

### Pedagogy

The programme employs a rich blend of instructional methods to foster deep learning, critical reflection, and practical application.

#### Live Online Sessions

Core instruction is delivered through synchronous, faculty-led sessions, broadcast in real-time to participant desktops or designated classrooms. These sessions are interactive and anchored in XLRI's commitment to academic rigor and practitioner relevance

#### Experiential Learning

The pedagogy draws on a diverse mix of teaching modalities, including case studies, role-plays, self-assessments, peer reflections, and guided experiential exercises—designed to translate insight into actionable leadership behaviors.

#### Learning Support Platform

All participants are provided access to XLRI's Cloud LMS, which serves as a central hub for learning materials, assignments, case studies, and assessments. The platform also facilitates asynchronous engagement with faculty, allowing participants to raise questions and receive support beyond the live classroom. The session recordings will be hosted on Veranda's platform which also provides session joining instructions and related trouble–shooting.

#### Cohort Engagement

A dedicated WhatsApp learning community supports real-time collaboration, idea-sharing, and ongoing dialogue between faculty and participants—deepening both peer learning and faculty interaction.

This multi-modal approach ensures that learning is engaging, applied, and sustained—not just during sessions, but throughout the participant's leadership journey.

## Assessment, Certification, & Executive Education Alumni Status

To ensure deep engagement and meaningful learning, the programme includes a continuous assessment framework designed around reflection, participation, and applied insight.

#### **Attendance Requirement:**

A minimum of 70% attendance in live, synchronous sessions is mandatory for programme completion.

#### **Evaluation Components:**

Assessment will be based on a combination of:

- Daily Diaries and Reflective Journals, designed to promote personal insight and sustained self-inquiry;
- Individual assignments that connect programme themes to leadership contexts;
- Sub-group projects and peer collaborations that reinforce collective learning.

These components are intentionally structured to **foster continuity**, **introspection**, **and accountability** throughout the leadership journey.

#### **Certification Criteria:**

- Participants who complete at least 80% of the assignments (to a satisfactory standard) and meet the attendance requirement will be awarded a Certificate of Successful Completion by XLRI.
- Participants who complete at least 50% of the assignments and meet the attendance requirement will be awarded a Certificate of Participation by XLRI.

#### **Executive Education Alumni Status:**

The candidates who receive the Successful Completion certificate are qualified to apply to the XLRI Aumni Association for Executive Alumni status of XLRI – Xavier School of Management. A one-time Executive Alumni Membership fee of ₹20,000 + GST will need to be paid during the application process.


